General Requirements

Applicants must have completed the equivalent of Canadian Grade 12 high school and must meet program-specific entrance requirements for admission.

Program Requirements

English Requirements

- **IELTS** (Academic) — overall score of 6.5 with no band score below 6.0
- **TOEFL** — score of 88 or higher (iBT) with no section below 20
- **CAEL** — score of 70
- **DET** (Duolingo English Test) — score of 110
- IB or AP English
